Directions to Fox Hills

From Ann Arbor: Take M-14 to Gotfredson Road (Exit #15). Left on Gotfredson to North Territorial Road. Left on North Territorial about one mile. Fox Hills is on the left.

From Dearborn, Westland, Livonia: Take I-96 (Jeffries Freeway) West. Follow signs that direct you to Ann Arbor. Take M-14 West to Gotfredson Road (Exit #15). Right on Gotfredson to North Territorial Road. Left on North Territorial about one mile. Fox Hills is on the left.

From Farmington Hills, Birmingham, Southfield: Take I-696 West to I-275 South to M-14. Take M-14 West to Gotfredson Road (Exit #15). Right on Gotfredson to North Territorial Road. Left on North Territorial about one mile. Fox Hills is on the left.

From Brighton, Howell, Flint: Take US-23 South to North Territorial Road. Take North Territorial east approximately 10 miles. Fox Hills is on the right.

From Metro Airport: Take I-94 West to I-275 North to M-14 West. Follow signs that direct you to Ann Arbor. Take M – 14 West to Gotfredson Road (Exit # 15). Right on Gotfredson to North Territorial Road. Left on North Territorial about one mile. Fox Hills is on the left.
